The Faulkner County Quorum Court met in its regular session at 6:00 PM on April 21, 2026, in Meeting Room A, located in the Faulkner County Courthouse with Judge Allen Dodson presiding.

The Court discussed Proposed Ordinance 26-07. This is an appropriation Ordinance to amend and supplement Faulkner County Ordinance 24-52 November 20, 2025), and to declare an emergency. Justice Moss made a motion to accept Proposed Ordinance 26-07, and such motion was seconded by Justice Shock. Counsel Murphy read Proposed Ordinance 26-07 by title only. Justice Moss made a motion to accept the change to Section 4 wherein County General Fund (1000) was changed to Emergency Squad Fund (3400). and Justice Meeks seconded such motion. Such motion was unanimously approved. After discussion, Judge Dodson called for a vote by roll call for Proposed Ordinance 26-07. The roll was called and Proposed Ordinance 26-07 was passed with a vote of 10-0.
