

PROPOSED ORDINANCE 26-11
Sponsored by the Personnel Committee

Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of Faulkner County, State of Arkansas.
An Ordinance to be entitled: An Ordinance to Create a Full-Time Position
in the Faulkner County Library Department beginning payroll week May 30, 2026,
and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Faulkner County Library is the largest and fastest growing of the class 6 county libraries in the state,

WHEREAS, the Faulkner County Library offered some 1,685 programs in 2025 with 63,569 attendees,

WHEREAS, the Faulkner County Library branches have inconsistent and sometimes substandard training in reading development,

WHEREAS, the Faulkner County Library has a pilot program to partner with school districts to support families and students in achieving their literacy goals,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Quorum Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas:

Section 1: One (1) new position is created in the Faulkner County Library Fund (3008), Department 0600 titled Youth Services Administrative Assistant. The salary for this position is \$34,755.08.

Section 2: \$31,307.81 is appropriated from the Faulkner County Library Fund (3008) to Department 0600, as follows:

\$20,050.95	1001 - Salaries, Full-time
\$ 1,533.90	1006 – Social Security Matching
\$ 3,071.81	1007 - Retirement
\$ 5,862.50	1009 – Insurance
\$ 304.78	1010 – Workmen’s Compensation
\$ 200.51	1011 – Unemployment
\$ 66.50	1016 – Life Insurance
\$ 216.86	1019 – Dental/Vision

Section 3: The adoption of this Ordinance is an emergency and therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
