Scope of Work:

Street Inventory: The selected contractor shall coordinate a roadway inventory and GIS map of approximately 1,000 centerline miles of improved roadways under the jurisdiction of Faulkner County, Arkansas (excluding undeveloped / un-improved / dirt / gravel / private roadways) utilizing existing data currently maintained by Faulkner County and held within established GIS databases.

Pavement Condition Assessment: The selected contractor shall record pavement distresses (or lack thereof) for each County Road section. It is the County's desire for the contractor to establish a condition index rating for each street section assessed. In addition, the selected contractor shall coordinate maps (large enough for public meetings) of the County's network of improved roads that illustrate the condition of the road based on a minimum coding of Excellent, Good, Fair, and Poor based upon existing road conditions. Any changes in pavement condition shall appear precisely on the map where the changes occur. All road conditions and distress data must be contained in a pavement management workbook and the data sorted in a way useful to Faulkner County's annual road improvement road selection process.

Method for Collecting and Recording Data: The selected contractor shall utilize electronic equipment designed for recording pavement distress within GIS format and produce geo-located video to an online condition map showing 100% of Faulkner County's improved road network and related right-of-way for each inspected road section. Also, uncompressed geolocated road video of Faulkner County's improved road network must also be made available to view using links from the online condition map. All information, data, and products become the property of Faulkner County, Arkansas.

Software and Hardware: The selected contractor shall provide literature and any other documents relevant for the County's review for the recommended software to archive and process data gathered by the contractor. The selected contractor shall include both an estimated cost for viewing software and an hourly rate for assistance and training Faulkner County, Arkansas to import data to a selected software/database system.
